## **City of Valdez Restrictions and Conditions:**

- (1) Comply with all federal, state and local regulations and gather all necessary permits, including USACOE and ADEC storm water erosion control permits;
- (2) Minimize the utilization and inconvenience of the right-of-way and other public areas by the public during the project;
- (3) Minimize all clearing, brushing, tree cutting, cleaning and removing debris within the designated work area to the extent only necessary for the completion of the project as shown on [EXHIBIT A: GIS MAP OR PLANSET FROM APPLICANT];
- (4) Notify Copper Valley Electric and Copper Valley Telecom about electrical, telephone and other overhead lines or underground lines that maybe impacted by cutting down any trees in the right of way or by the above mentioned activity;
- (5) Throughout tree falling, proof of insurance is required and the permittee or agents will hold the City of Valdez harmless for any property damage or personal injury as a result of allowing tree removal;
- (6) The permittee will appear and defend the City of Valdez from claims or suits brought to halt work and to comply with any orders of the Court;
- (7) If the permittee expands the permitted work area beyond the segment of right-of-way herein described, then a review of applicable criteria and amendment of this permit will be required, save that limit revisions determined by City of Valdez Fire Department for emergency access will be resolved under this permit;
- (8) Any monument or survey marker removed, disturbed or destroyed as a result of the work done shall be replaced at the permittee's expense;
- (9) Restore and repair any areas used or damaged during the utilization of work at permittee's expense;
- (10) Remove overburden and organic and woody debris from the roadway lens;
- (11) Stripped overburden deposited within the right-of-way shall be placed outside the roadway structure, be dimensionally stable and not subject to sloughing or sliding, and shall not block any drainages;
- (12) Contact the City of Valdez for **inspections** at the time of rough grade clearing, installation of drainage structures, road bed placement and compaction, and upon completion of finished surfacing;
- (13) Install and maintain adequate drainage and drainage improvements to convey drainage into natural channels throughout the project;
- (14) When appropriate, a Traffic Control plan must be in use when working in public right-of-way; the plan shall conform to Federal Highway Administration of the USDOT guidelines;
- (15) Security deposit has been provided by applicant OR a waiver for a security deposit has been granted.
- (16) The City of Valdez reserves the right to direct changes as necessary to ensure adequate safety and competence of the right-of-way.
